Produce Boxes

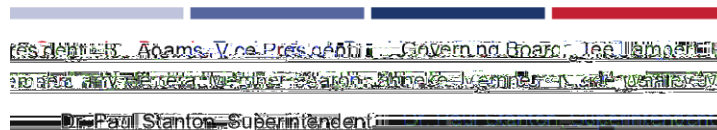

Estimados Padres y Guardianes,

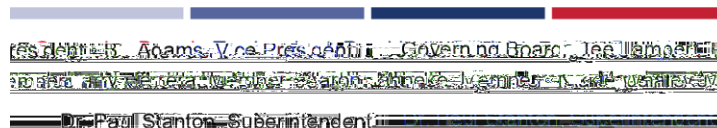
