Bullying/Cyberbullying Prevention

Our Social Services Department provides interventions to support students in making good choices. Homerooms meet weekly to support these topics. Students at Royal Palm are encouraged and empowered to report bullying, including cyberbullying, incidents anonymously through the following process:

- Students may fill out an incident report found in the Student Center. The reports are reviewed and processed by the social worker and/or the student services specialist.
- Classroom teachers may, at any time, refer specific student behaviors related to bullying directly to the Student Center. Students found to be bullying others will be disciplined up to and including suspension or expulsion from school. Law enforcement shall be notified any time there is a reasonable belief that an incident of bullying is in violation of the law.
